






WEAVING =
INTERLOCKING HORIZONTAL
AND VERTICAL THREAD





VERTICAL THREADS = WARP



HORIZONTAL THREADS = WEFT

Weft threads alternate going over and under the warp threads to lock them into place







We first see cloth weaving 12,000 years ago during the Neolithic Period.

Before weaving, ancient people used animal hides for clothing





Humans were likely inspired by nature to invent weaving






Ancient peoples also used the weaving process with twigs and branches to create fences, shelters, and baskets.



Bob Young lives in Hindman and learned how to weave when he was a teenager










Weaving first started as a way to make useful things, like clothes and blankets.
